

To be considered for Florida American Legion Boys State you must schedule an interview with an American Legion Post close to you. Your school Guidance Counselor may be in touch with the local Post and know who to contact for an interview. If not, contact the state Programs Director by calling 800.393.3378x222.

Selected applicants will be awarded an all-expense paid trip to Tallahassee, participate in events in the State Capitol and have an opportunity to earn three (3) hours of college credit.

To be eligible, you must have completed 11th grade by the end of this school year, have an un-weighted GPA of 3.2 and have at least one full semester remaining in your senior year. Boys State is the premier youth leadership program in Florida so please give careful thought to your answers.

Feel free to attach your resume or use an additional sheet of paper for your responses. This application may be used by your local American Legion Post for your interview.
