The student's relative may be living or deceased. Please see the following instructions for assembling a packet and mailing to the address below.

INCLUDE IN YOUR PACKET:

- 1) A valid DD214 from student's relative (assistance is available to obtain this document)
- 2) A 2-page typed essay (double space) on "What the Constitution Means to Me"
- 3) A printed and completed application available on the website: www.americanlegionpost84.com/programs
- 4) A current transcript from your high school
- 5) A letter of acceptance from the college of your choice, if available. If not available by May 1, 2012, it will be needed prior to receiving any scholarship monies.
- 6) A minimum 5 letters of recommendation from various areas representing the student's life. Please limit letters to one per area. For example, one teacher recommendation, one church affiliated recommendation, one employer letter of recommendation, one letter per club affiliation or hobby activity, etc.

*Please note that omission of any of the above information will result in the disqualification of the application. All items must be submitted together and postmarked by May 1, 2012.
